2021 Special Collection Guide

Items such as Bulky Garbage, Metal Items, and Construction & Demolition (C&D) can be placed out as part of the special collection. Collection **WILL NOT NECESSARILY TAKE PLACE ON YOUR REGULAR SCHEDULED COLLECTION DAY**. To ensure collection follow the rules below.

- ♦ Items such as roofing shingles, insulation, and small items must be placed in clear non-coloured bags.
- ♦ **Place items curbside by 6:30am on Monday of your scheduled week, within 3m of the curb.**
- ♦ Construction materials, metal items, & bulky garbage items must be in separate piles.
- ♦ **Construction materials must be in a pile no larger than 4ft x 4ft x 8ft.**
- ♦ Items must not exceed 50kgs in weight for any one item or 150kgs for all items for any one premise.

What's In

Pile 1. Bulky Garbage

Box spring and mattress, sofas, furniture, chairs, tables, etc.

Pile 2. Metal

Washers & dryers, refrigerators, stoves, barbeques, bicycles, etc.

Pile 3. C&D

Drywall, plaster, cellulose, flooring, lumber, toilets, asphalt shingles, vinyl siding, etc. Roofing shingles and insulation must be placed in clear non-coloured bags.

Materials must be placed in three separate piles within 3m of the curb. No item shall exceed 2m in any dimension.

Hazardous Waste (propane tanks, paint)
Loose unmanageable material
Electronics and Tires

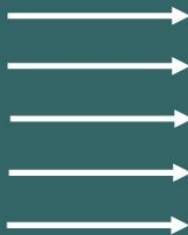
WILL NOT BE COLLECTED
