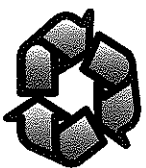

# WASTE SEPARATION GUIDE FOR RESIDENTS

### Special Collection

May 5-9, 2008

#### What's Accepted?

White Goods such as refrigerators, freezers, washers & dryers, & air conditioners. Bulky items such as furniture, box springs, mattresses, & toys.

\*Items shall not exceed 50kg in weight for any one item or 150kg for all items from any one premise. No item shall exceed 2m in any dimension.

#### Construction & Demolition

##### (C&D) Collection

May 26-30, 2008

C&D collection includes lumber, doors, windows, gyproc, roofing, siding, carpet, & wood flooring.

#### Reminder

All materials must be placed for collection by **7:00 am**, within 3 meters of the curb.

#### Landfill Operating Hours

Monday - Friday

7:00am - 3:00pm

Saturday

8:00am - 12:00noon

### ORGANICS (GREEN CARD) COLLECTED BI-WEEKLY

#### WHAT'S IN

##### Food Waste

- All dairy products
- All fruits and peelings
- All vegetables and peelings
- Bread products
- Coffee grounds & filters
- Meat, fish, & bones
- Pasta, grains & rice
- Tea leaves & bags



##### Soiled Paper Products

- Damp and soiled papers
- Food napkins
- Paper plates & paper towels
- Pizza boxes

##### Leaf & Yard Waste

Branches not exceeding 1.5m in length, 5cm in diameter, and 25kg in weight, must be tied together and placed beside bin.

Grass, leaves, & plant waste (up to 10 clear bags can be placed beside green bin)

**Absolutely no pet waste, plastic, or sanitary products**

### RECYCLING CLEAR BAGS COLLECTED BI-WEEKLY

- Aluminum cans
- Aluminum pie plates & foil
- Books—soft and hard cover
- Boxboard—cereal boxes
- Corrugated cardboard
- Clear plastic wrap
- Detergent boxes
- Envelopes
- Glass beverage containers
- Glass food containers
- Juice boxes
- Milk cartons
- Newspaper & flyers
- Magazines & phonebooks
- Office paper
- Plastic beverage and food containers
- Plastic bags
- Plastic containers #'s 1-7
- Steel and tin cans



#### \*\*Please note\*\*

All items must be clean & dry (absolutely no food waste)

Remove caps, metal & plastic bindings (place in garbage)

Cardboard must be flattened and tied in bundles no larger than 2ft. x 3ft x 8"

### GARBAGE CLEAR OR COLORED BAGS COLLECTED BI-WEEKLY

*The following list includes materials that should be placed in your regular garbage.*

- Broken glass, ceramics & dishes
- Candy bar wrappers
- Calculators & pens
- Clothes & footwear
- Cigarette butts and ashes
- CDs, cassettes & video tapes
- Diapers

- Laminated items

- Liners from cereal boxes
- Meat trays
