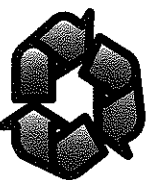

Curbside Collection Reminders

- ◆ All materials must be placed for collection by **7:00 am**, within 3 meters of the curb.
- ◆ Composting and recycling are mandatory.
- ◆ Construction and Demolition Debris (wood, shingles, siding, etc.) will not be collected curbside.

Food Waste
